Professor-Advisor system



In recent years, to improve the satisfaction of users, the environment has been improved by operating a mobile app library, building an unmanned book return machine, replacing the electronic information room PC, replacing the seating system, and ionizer.

University Newspaper

The newspaper is a university magazine that delivers news from our students and faculty, alumni, high schools nationwide, university media, and related organizations. Currently, the university newspaper, 'Halla Chun-Chu', which is published with 4 or 8 pages per month, publishes about 2,000 copies each print and conveys the contents of the university's internal and external activities to the outside, and is a channel of continuous interest between the university, students, and society. The educational broadcasting station was launched to realize the founding ideology of Cheju Halla University and to promote a healthy university culture. The International Education Center helps foreign students studying at Cheju Halla University with academic affairs and listens to and resolves difficulties related to life so that foreign students can enjoy a smooth study abroad life.

• Global Industry-Academia Cooperation Center

By providing job training and language training through overseas employment programs supported by Cheju Halla University and the Human Resources Development Service of Korea, we are supporting young people who wish to work abroad and those who are expecting to graduate to develop overseas employment capabilities.

International Development Cooperation Center

The International Development Cooperation Center was formed at Cheju Halla University to reinforce the university's public development assistance capabilities through smooth execution of Korea's international development public-private cooperation projects.

Lifelong Education Center

The university's human and material resources are utilized to provide educational opportunities to the general public and professionals. While practicing the philosophy of lifelong education that students must learn for a lifetime, we are raising the cultural awareness and intellectual level of adults in the community. By helping to improve the quality of real life at home and at work, we strive to make the most of adult learners' abilities for the development of local communities and the nation. To this end, our university cooperates with Jeju Special Self-Governing Province and develops and operates educational programs for mutual growth of local governments, universities and local communities. The contents of education consist of the contents necessary for real life, employment, and entrepreneurship, such as obtaining credits, obtaining a certificate, preparing for a business start-up, and health education. Students who have completed the education are provided with high-quality lifelong learning opportunities to maintain the level of a semi-professional. We are opening the university's door to adult learners, providing an opportunity to acquire a degree.

Disabled Student Support Center

This student center aims to actively support students with disabilities to make sure that they can study with ease through improvement of the educational environment and support for learning, and to maximize the effect of inclusive education with students. It is also contributing to the development of the welfare for the disabled in the local community by consulting and supporting the disabled with any inconveniences and difficulties to improve the learning and university life conditions in the school. The Disabled Student Support Center is currently on the 4th floor of the Kumho Future Hall, and the assistive technology equipment in the Disabled Student Support Center includes electric wheelchairs, manual wheelchairs, wheelchair-height desks, crutches, reading magnifiers for the visually impaired, recording devices, and a white cane, a sound amplifying device for the hearing impaired, and a mobile electric bed and a laptop for learning.

Infirmary

The infirmary is equipped with equipment for general health check-ups such as blood pressure measurement and body fat test, a treatment room for simple medication and trauma treatment, and a space for students and faculty who need a break to relax.

Halla Convention Center

The Halla Convention Center is equipped with a multipurpose room and various auxiliary facilities to hold various meetings and events. It is playing a pivotal role in nurturing world-class hotel and tourism talent through practical classes and field training, as well as convenient spaces for students.

ACADEMY-INDUSTRY COOPERATION ORGANIZATION

Human Resources Development Institute

Vocational Training Center

Provides opportunities for capacity development to employees working at SMEs through the training of local and industry–specific manpower. It provides stable manpower supply and productivity improvement to business owners, and utilizes excellent training facilities and equipment to train on–site manpower required by SMEs through customized education. It provides education to improve the job skills of workers.

Joint training center

The joint training center is equipped with a training system that teaches in-demand, job-specific skills. By educating professional manpower through practical training, the quality of employment is improved, the competitiveness of learning workers is maximized, and field-oriented manpower required by the industry is produced. To this end, it aims to improve educational conditions and learning quality and strengthen field-oriented education through the development of customized curriculum with companies and improvement of learning methods.

· Employment and Startup Support Center

It provides career guidance for students, supports personal competency development, provides employment information, and links with recruiting industries. It collects employment information, operates an employment information network, and develops and operates various employment support programs. It develops and manages programs related to strengthening links with external related organizations and industries and developing human resources.

Halla-Newcastle PBL Education Research Institute

Halla-Newcastle PBL Education Research Institute was established in January 2002 with the goal of 'cultivating professionals with practical skills and knowledge in the field' under the vision of the university as a "Central University in Northeast Asia".

The research institute supports the development of PBL textbooks for the development and spread of PBL as a way to cultivate creative talents in the 4th industrial era. In addition, various academic, educational and research activities are held, such as hosting summer/winter workshops for domestic professors, holding an international PBL academic symposium, and publishing the Journal of Problem-Based Learning.

BI Center

The BI Center is connected with university specialization in the 3D Integrated Technology Institute, Engineering Technology Education Innovation Center, Information Technology Education Research Institute, Design Center, Food Art Center, and Jeju Local Food Research Institute, as well as nursing, health, home, social practice and information and communication fields within the university. Thus, we will support venture startups based on BT and IT, and foster technology-intensive small and medium-sized enterprises through practical industry-academia cooperation.

Instructional Media Development Center

This center aims to support the development, production, and operation of educational media and online contents to improve the quality of education and improve the excellence of teaching and learning. To this end, it supports the development and production of educational media (e-learning contents, e-Books, etc.), holds special lectures on the development and production of e-learning educational media, establishes and promotes content development policies using OCW and MOOC to activate flip-learning, and e-learning. It supports these learning education program operations and system operations.

Culture and Tourism Education Research Institute

It establishes policies and academic theories so that the field of culture and tourism can develop in a balanced way based on productive rationality through grasping the current status of all fields of cultural tourism inside and outside of Jeju Special Self-Governing Province and researching and solving problems. It was established in 1991 for the purpose of discovering, preserving, organizing, researching, and promoting the use of tourism resources in Jeju-do folk culture.

MCTRI

The Center for Future Culture Technology (MCTRI) has established a multidisciplinary convergence technology research system that can create social, economic, and educational value by gathering excellent research groups within the school, and it plays a role as a global cultural technology hub for practical and commercialization of research results.

· Jeju Artificial Intelligence Research Center

Jeju Institute of Artificial Intelligence (CAII) aims to develop innovative source technologies related to artificial intelligence in preparation for the advent of a revolutionary technological society, and to research its multi-industry applied technologies. It has a special purpose for R&D and consultation of customized artificial intelligence technologies for the realization of smart cities and smart tourism, and it helps the development and distribution of educational programs to cultivate human resources professionals.

• LIMS (Laboratory of Intelligent Man/Machine System)

LIMS (Laboratory of IMS), which aims to implement Intelligent Man/Machine Systems (IMS), conducts research to realize human artificial intelligence, and conducts research through securing excellent research personnel. By participating in research based on neural networks showing recent successful results, we create excellent research results and aim to be the best in the field of applied research based on 2D–3D image research. In the school, as a leading research institute related to artificial intelligence, it cooperates with other research institutes and supports research technology.

• Engineering Technology Education Innovation Center

The Engineering Technology Education Innovation Center supports capstone design (engineering comprehensive design education program) for engineering departments, opens related courses, and develops enterprise–linked education and experience programs to improve the quality of engineering education programs. It aims to cultivate global engineering talents and strengthen the competitiveness of local industries.

Broadcasting Video Cent

In accordance with the role and importance of the visual culture industry in modern society, we aim to possess the infrastructure of the visual cultural contents field and cultivate creative broadcasting contents experts by activating the cultural contents of the visual center and converting its quality. It conducts research support for the government, government, organizations, or industries, and conducts research and education on technology development for new growth engines such as research and information collection and new technology development for each field of the information industry. It will contribute the the local community as well as the nation.

KADI (Korean Art & Design Institute)

KADI is an art and design research institute based on design infrastructure and research. Facilitating international exchanges with domestic and foreign related schools, organizations, and associations, leading conferences and campaigns through exchanges with renowned designers at home and abroad, and hosting and participating in events such as domestic and overseas exhibitions. It aims to promote the popularization and specialization of art and design through the expansion of the base of design, improvement of professionalism, and expansion.

Convergence Media Design Center

It was established to lead the design field by creating a design research and development environment that mainly deals with virtual experiences that integrate future design fields such as VR, AR, and MR. Based on research on development of VR, AR design, 3D, and video design including visual event content and media facade (projection mapping, media wall, etc.) content, we intend to contribute to the vitalization of local community video design business

• Maker Space Center

The Makerspace Center establishes a 'creative activity platform based on creative ideas', and continuously conducts research on production methods and improvement of the user environment for creating global-level product results.



Marine Leisure Sports Center

As a license testing center and educational institution designated by the Maritime Police Agency, it carries out tasks to train marine leisure manpower through boat and yacht license acquisition education and water safety education.

Medical Welfare Education Research Institute

The Institute for Medical Welfare Education aims to contribute to the country and society by actively volunteering to increase the capacity of the local community through medical health and welfare education. In order to actively cope with the changing health and medical environment, it is striving to reinforce its core competencies in the fields of health, nursing, and welfare, and to play a leading role in the characterization and competitiveness of universities.

Free International City Center

It aims to improve the knowledge of Free International City or related academics and cultures and their application, and further contribute to academic exchange in related fields, development of Jeju Free International City, and international publicity.

Halla • Stony Brook Emergency Medical Education Center

In line with the launch of the Free International City and Jeju Special Self–Governing Province, an academic exchange cooperation agreement was signed with the State University of New York (Stony Brook) in the United States for further vitalization of international exchange and practical international education. The Emergency Medical Education Center was opened. Halla–Stony Brook Emergency Medical Training Center is the largest simulation center in Korea and has played a leading role in domestic simulation education. As a specialized cardiac rescue) training site, it produces nursing health workers with international qualifications. In addition, it is operating First Airway LLC's Difficult Airway Provider for emergency medical professionals in connection with New York State University program for the first time in Korea.

Food Art Center

The Food Art Center was established to enhance the food culture of Jeju Special Self–Governing Province. It aims to nurture food culture leaders who can lead the food culture in Jeju by operating differentiated lectures and contents in professionally developed and organized educational programs from a leading position.

Jeju Local Food Research Institute

The Jeju Local Food Research Institute aims to lead the dietary life pattern of modern people who are becoming more sophisticated and diversified in the 21st century. Competition for food is getting sharper due to low-cost imported food ingredients and processed imported foods coming from abroad, including China. To establish a position for international food development using local foods, analysis of components of functional foods, and research on physiologically active substances, and to scientifically, modernize, and internationalize traditional Jeju foods such as knowledge dissemination and information exchange on local foods. It was established to conduct research projects.

Halla • Nankai University Korean Language and Culture Research Center

The Center for Korean Language and Culture Studies at Halla-Nankai University was established jointly by our university and Nankai University in China in August 2011 to further expand the field of development of Chinese language and culture education and international exchange cooperation.

Equine Industrial Education Research Institute

The Equine Industry Education Research Institute specializes in tourism in Jeju Special Self–Governing Province by cultivating essential manpower in the industrial field, such as horse riding and horse racing skills and business management, to share knowledge and information necessary for the development of the horse industry, as well as for industrial workers. It is an industry that aims to contribute to the development of the horse industry, a new growth industry in the 21st century in Korea.

Fauine Industry Promotion Support Center

The Equine Industry Promotion Support Center aims to actively serve the local community through the supply of technologies and manpower in various fields necessary for fostering the horse–related industry.

Jeju Community Nursing Center

The operation vision of the Jeju Community Nursing Center is to perform all activities to improve the health level of the local community by jointly utilizing professional manpower and facilities to promote the health of the local community, strengthen all activities, develop and operate a close cooperation system with local community organizations, increase the development of programs related to health problems of local residents, improve indicators related to cardio–cerebrovascular disease, hypertension, and diabetes, and efficiently perform cardiovascular disease prevention management. It is to develop and carry out educational programs for reinforcing activities that accompany the healing and health of local residents, education for the elderly and preventing dementia.

Early Childhood Teacher Education Center

This training center intends to operate a variety of training courses for the faculty and staff of early childhood education institutions to strengthen their professionalism and on-site practical skills. Currently, we are conducting group education related to childcare such as general job education, promotion education, and pre-director job education, and we are conducting research in related fields for quality lectures. In addition, we are planning various educational programs by supporting teaching and learning methods by field teachers and activating mutual exchanges with industry companies.

Small and Medium Business Industry-Academia Cooperation Center

As a specialized institution for the promotion of industry–academia cooperation projects, it participates in projects entrusted by local governments, strengthens the annual industry–university cooperation system by linking between universities and small and medium–sized enterprises in and outside the province, and strives to improve the technology of SMEs through exchanges. For the purpose of other centers, such as attracting and managing industry–academia–research technology development projects, R&D project management and training for support companies, business support projects such as solving difficult technologies, operation of a consultative body in Jeju for small and medium–sized enterprises industry–academia cooperation, research expenses, etc. It was established and operated for the purpose of expanding the industrial base of local communities and strengthening the competitiveness of SMEs by playing a corresponding role.
