White Day, Time to Return the Feelings

White Day is a romantic holiday in March where boys give gifts to girls. It is a way for men to respond to the gifts they received from women on Valentine's Day. White Day is celebrated on March 14th, exactly one month after Valentine's Day.

On February 14th in Korea, girls give out chocolates to their valentine. In response, the men celebrating White Day giving gifts to the girls in response for the chocolate they received to show that they reciprocate the affections the women have shown them. Typically, these gifts are candy, chocolate, or other types of gifts such as teddy bears.

White Day originated from Japan, which was known then as Marshmallow Day. On White Day (or Marshmallow Day), men return the favor by giving women white marshmallows. Later on, they changed the name to White Day to make it more open-ended. In this way, men wouldn't be limited to just give marshmallows but anything white such as white chocolate.



All Students Are Automatically Registered under NHIS

Starting from March 1, 2021, all international students in Korea are registered automatically under National Health Insurance Service (NHIS).

With NHIS, the hospital is able to confirm the insurance status through ARC and the coverage will be applied directly to the hospital bill.

Insurance Fee should be fully paid on time by the 25th each month (prepayment). Students with unpaid bill won't be covered and might have some restrictions on visa extension process.

Insurance Fee:

- From 2021.03 ~ 2022.02: 30% = KRW 39,540
- From 2022.03 ~ 2023.02: 40% = KRW 52,716
- From 2023.03 ~ : 50% = 65,890

Coverage:

- Inpatient: 80%
- Outpatient: 40%~70% (Depends on the type of treatment)
- Some treatments might not be covered. Make sure to confirm in advance with the hospital.

Notes:

- Monthly bill is sent to student's registered address.
- Monthly bill will be sent in both Korean and English.
- Payment method:
 - ✓ Virtual Account
 - ✓ Automatic Transfer
 - ✓ Homepage
 - ✓ Mobile App
 - ✓ Bank Transfer
 - ✓ Etc.
- In case of information changes (address, passport, visa type, etc), it should be reported to NHIS.

Agreement with Kyung Hee University Graduate School of International Studies

CHU Office of Academic Affairs (Director: Seokyeong Ko) signed an educational cooperation agreement with Kyung Hee University Graduate School of International Studies at the conference room of Halla Convention Center on Tuesday, January 26th.

In accordance with this agreement, both universities agreed to operate a joint educational program for the graduates of Cheju Halla University to enter the Graduate School of International Studies at Kyung Hee University and to promote academic advancement after admission.

In the future, the two universities decided to explore various ways for mutual development together.



CHU has been selected as IEQAS University (Degree/Language Training Course)

On February 15th, the Ministry of Education announced the results of the final selection of universities certified for International Education Quality Assurance System (IEQAS). CHU received an honor of being continuously selected as IEQAS University since 2014.

This certification system was introduced by the Ministry of Education and the National Research Foundation of Korea. CHU has obtained both degree and language training certifications, and this certification will give some benefits, such as: simplified procedure for issuing foreign student visas, additional points when selecting GKS students, prioritized participation of international education exhibition, etc.

Wuikyung Shin, Vice President of Office of International Affairs expressed "Internationalization of universities is a more important period now than ever. Even though it is difficult to do International agreement and exchange of students due to COVID-19, CHU will overcome this and actively participate in the ever-changing global education and establish ourselves as one of the best Global Universities."

March 1st Independence Movement Day

March First Movement, also called Samil Independence Movement, series of demonstrations for Korean national independence from Japan that began on March 1, 1919, in the Korean capital city of Seoul and soon spread throughout the country. Before the Japanese finally suppressed the movement 12 months later, approximately 2,000,000 Koreans had participated in more than 1,500 demonstrations. About 7,000 people were killed by the Japanese police and soldiers, and 16,000 were wounded; 715 private houses, 47 churches, and 2 school buildings were destroyed by fire. Approximately 46,000 people were arrested, of whom some 10,000 were tried and convicted.

The movement was begun by 33 Korean cultural and religious leaders who, after almost 10 years of Japanese rule, drew up a Korean "Proclamation of Independence" and then organized a mass demonstration in Seoul for March 1, 1919, their late emperor's commemoration day. On the appointed day, the 33 leaders, hoping to bring international pressure on Japan to end her colonial rule in Korea, signed and read their proclamation and had co-conspirators read it in townships throughout the country. The suppressed anti-Japanese feelings of Koreans were released in one great explosion, and mass demonstrations took place in many parts of the country, forming the largest national protest rallies against foreign domination in Korean history.

Though the movement failed to bring about its paramount goal of national independence, it was significant in strengthening national unity, leading to the birth in Shanghai of the Korean Provisional Government and drawing worldwide attention. Finally, the failure of the March First Movement greatly enhanced the rise of the Korean communist party. Today, March 1 is a national holiday in both North and South Korea.

QR Check-in app used in registered places where visitors need to confirm their visit to the place.

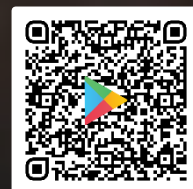
Main features:
